Community Engagement & Development

Building hope and transforming our community is the core of our activities at HPCT, through Te Whare Awhero we are able to engage considerable with our community and those tasked with leadership in our community. Three areas have been key for us in the area of community engagement.

- Completion of Participatory Action Research Project with the Riccarton Wigram Community board and key Christchurch City Council staff in our area. The research is available from blair@hopcentre.net.nz and the strategic plan from the Christchurch City Council.
- Capacity Building Project with partners in Selwyn and the Ministry of Social Development to build the capacity of community organisations. Copies of the strategic plan can be obtained from admin@hopecentre.net.nz.

Thirdly and related to the above we have been providing significant leadership through change for Heartlands Services in Hornby which was impacted upon by the Work and Income shootings in Ashburton. As a result, security measures have impacted negatively on service users accessing Heartlands.

In response whilst maintaining business as usual we have led a high level of community engagement to explore future well-being services in the Greater Hornby area and working with others to ensure services are maximised to meet the community's needs. This conversation is developing further concepts around Holistic Care, integrated and collocated services.

Horizons Oscar (Children's Programs)

Horizons Oscar is based in Hornby, Christchurch under the Hornby Presbyterian Community Trust banner and, up until September 2012, we were known as Hornby Presbyterian Community Oscar.

We are committed to providing quality, affordable childcare programmes for the community. We have been restructuring our programmes and rebranding so that we can provide the best before school, after school and school holiday programme care that we can. At Horizons Oscar, we endeavour to create an atmosphere where your children feel safe and secure. We offer a well-supervised, fun safe, learning environment for your child. We aim to help the children learn good values, experience new challenges and develop new skills.

Children are provide with afternoon tea, help with homework, structured activities and time for free play. We are able to provide transport at a small cost, from some of the surrounding schools. Check out the enrolment page or contact the office for more information.

All our OSCAR Staff are police checked and well trained. We work on an on-site staff ratio of 1:10 and 1:8 ratio when on outings.
